PROGRAM:

On Tuesday, May 7th, from 7:30 to 8:30 PM, at the monthly meeting of the Petaluma Arts Association, meet Bay Area artist Joyce Hasselbeck. Watch her demo on her Splish-Splash techniques — then Splish Splash your own way into creating amazing imaginative effects in watercolor! Begin painting freely. Courageously make your first splish-splash stroke—or spill! Then develop it further with more paint into an image ... or leave it as an abstract form. You will learn to see things in a new, exciting way—through your artist's eyes. Learn to have fun with the loose, expressive media of watercolor. Learn a few experimental approaches to stretch your boundaries. Encourage your spontaneity. Explore and discover your creative self. Hasselbeck is a signature member of both the Pastel Society of the West Coast and the Society of Western Artists, a member of the Santa Rosa Art Guild. Her natural ability was apparent from childhood. Professional recognition is evidenced by the many awards she has received in art shows. Hasselbeck has an excellent reputation for fine commission portraits, paintings and murals; and is highly respected as a teacher, lecturer-demonstrator and art show judge.
