



62nd Annual Art in the Park September 13th, 2020

Eligibility: All artists who create original visual art or fine crafts are welcome. Exhibited works are subject to approval by the Petaluma Arts Association.

Profit from Art in the Park goes to promote art in the schools and the community.

All participants must have created the artwork they display and must be present for the entire show. Participants selling work they did not directly create will be asked to leave and their money will not be refunded.

However, PAA members may sell artwork created by their immediate family, spouse, partner, or children. Members intending to exhibit their immediate family's artwork must submit photos of the artwork they wish to exhibit with their application and are subject to approval by the Art in the Park committee.

Non-members, artists who have not exhibited at Art in the Park within the last three years, or who will be displaying substantially different work should submit four photos of recent work that accurately represent the work to be displayed, along with a photo of their outdoor booth setup. If a photo is not available, a drawing is acceptable. The art/craft pieces displayed at Art in the Park must be the same type and quality as the description and photos submitted with the application. Applications will be accepted until August 31, 2020.

Booth Spaces: No more than 4 artists may share a booth. Both artists must be members of PAA for the member price to apply. Artists are expected to keep their displays and belongings within their booth space. Please store boxes and supplies under covered tables or in another tasteful manner. No artwork is allowed on benches, picnic tables, or pathways. Due to liability issues, vendors may not bring their dogs.

Booth Assignments: A map of the park is provided with the registration form.

Artists may indicate their top 3 booth choices on the registration form. If their top 3 choices are not available, every effort will be made to place artists in a booth space close to one of their selections.

All requests for a specific location will be taken until July 15th, 2020. Applications received after that date will be assigned booth spaces by PAA. Once all spaces on the map are filled PAA will open additional spaces.

Booths will be assigned in the following priority:

1st PAA members by date received.

2nd Non-members by date received.

Artists are responsible for supplying any equipment to exhibit their artwork. These include items such as canopies, tables, displays, etc...

There are a limited number of 10x15 and 10x20 spaces. Two 10x10 spaces may be combined in spaces 1-4 to make a 10x20 space.

The 10x15 spaces are 5, 6, and 7 only.

Confirmation letters with your assigned booth space will be sent out beginning July 10th.

Commission: There is a 20% commission payable to PAA on ALL sales. We use the honor system. However, if a vendor does not report all sales they will not be allowed to participate next year. Your check should be made out to PAA when paying your commission. Please remember that profits go to promote art in the schools and the community.

Participants can accept payment by cash or check with buyers' valid ID. Also by use of electronic payment apps for smartphones or tablets. Please keep in mind that there is no public wi-fi service available in Walnut Park.

Set up/take down: 6:30-9:30am and after 5:00pm. There will be Boy Scouts to help unload/load, put up/take down canopies, tents, etc. that you have supplied*. They offer great assistance and it is customary to tip them. *PAA provides the booth space only.

Demonstrations: We encourage you to demonstrate your art at Art in the Park.
